## Financial Report

Review of Financial report by Treasurer Mary Kay Lee. Current net worth is $\$ 93,766$. Notable expenses were to April 2013 raffle winners, Larsen Bakery for kringle fundraiser, Franklin Post Office for post office box and a $\$ 20,000$ transfer from checking to $C D$. Revenue included fundraising and donations as well as sponsorships. For a complete list see Financial Summary.

Compared to same period of 2012 our net worth has increased $\$ 21,537$.

## 2013 Fall Weekend Camp - Friday, November 8 - Sunday, November 10, 2013

Applications will be available mid-August. The cost will be $\$ 32$ per person for two nights. Campers will be obligated to pay the registration fee.

## 2013 Summer Camp - Saturday, July 27 - Friday, August 2, 2013

Applications are due today, May 4, 2013. As of today, 24 camper applications have been received and 15 volunteers along with 3 others that have committed. Additional volunteers (both male and female) are needed.

Confirmations will be sent out June 1.

Actual cost is $\$ 60.75$ per person, per night (Friday, $\$ 30.25$ ). One person staying the entire week costs \$334.

## Transportation

Dennis, Margaret, Mary Ann and Jeana have all requested transportation. We will attempt to work within the organization to provide transportation so as to not have to go through a transit company.

Jean Wiza is able to transport one or two people depending on hoyer situations. Bonnie L. will be contacted to see if she is available to transport anyone. Julie C. will be able to take Jeana.

## Hospital Beds

Beds should be ordered in mid-June. Mary Kay will be able to provide Erica with the name of the company that has been used in the past. If the individual has had success in using their insurance before they should contact them again this year and make their own arrangements.

## Hoyer Lifts
